She does not want to go and help her mummy but Glory remembers yesterday. She remembers that the Lord Jesus wants her to obey with a happy face.

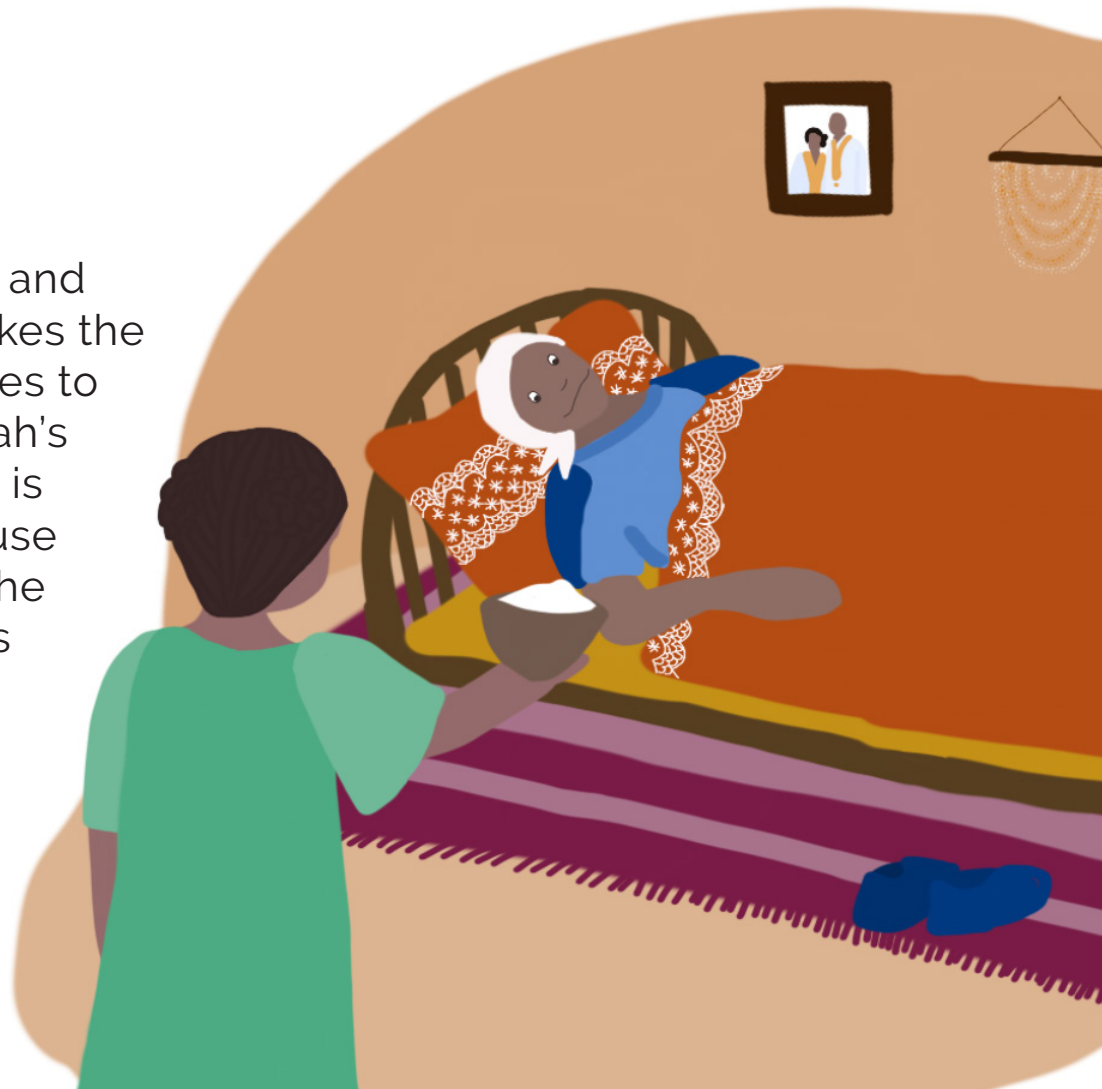


Quickly Glory jumps up. She puts her stick carefully under the tree where she can find it later. She runs into the house and says, "Yes Mummy, what do you want me to do?"
